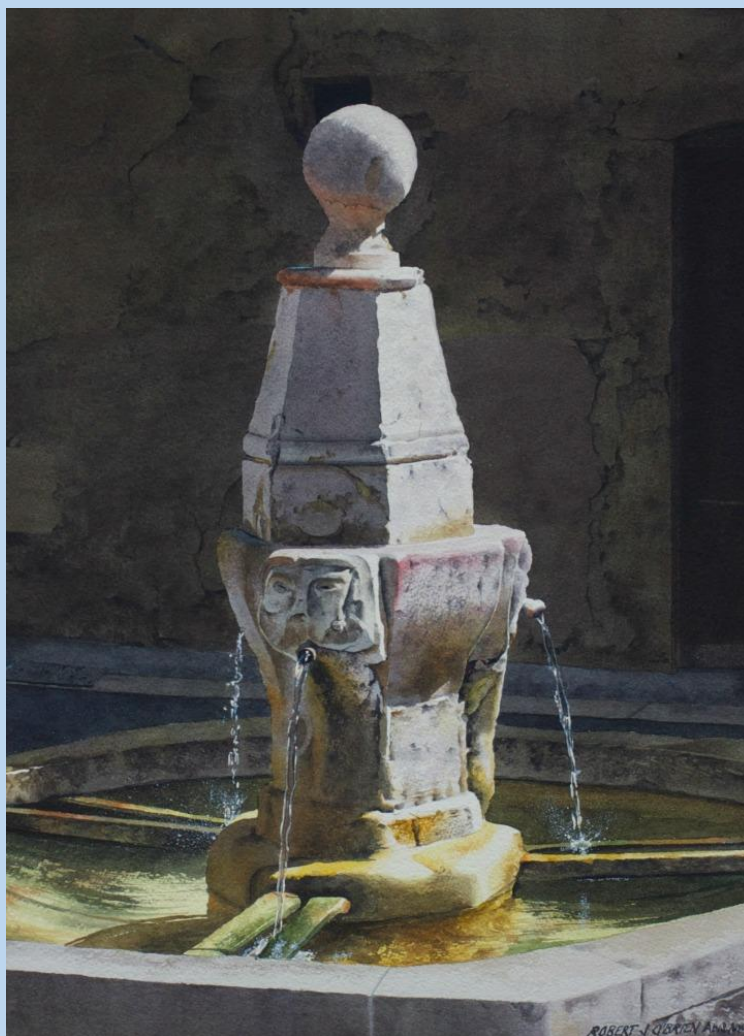


Painting the Many Moods and Facets of WATER in Watercolor

This workshop will focus on the many moods and facets of painting water in the watercolor medium and to learn techniques from rendering a simple reflective puddle to a swift moving mountain stream and everything in between. Foreshortening and the ability to suggest a flat plane will be taught when painting a meandering river or a lake. Water provides the artist with an endless variety of interpretations given its reflective qualities as well as its restlessness. The class will start with a demonstration by the instructor followed by class painting. A critique will be offered at the end of the class. Reference photos will be provided and students are encouraged to bring their own as well. A materials list will be provided upon request.
