


Portrait Drawing & Painting



Learning to draw and paint the portrait is a delightful journey. It challenges the artist to see subtle angles and shapes. This class is for both beginner and advanced artist wishing to learn about drawing and painting the portrait. The first five classes will focus on positioning the model, general anatomy, and defining the planes of the head. Demonstrations will be given. The first five classes will be in charcoal and the final four will focus on oil. Optionally students may work in their own media choice with approval. There will be a variety of models: male, female, young and old, all rotating between the first 5 classes. The last FOUR classes will be devoted to one long pose giving students ample time to study the form.
